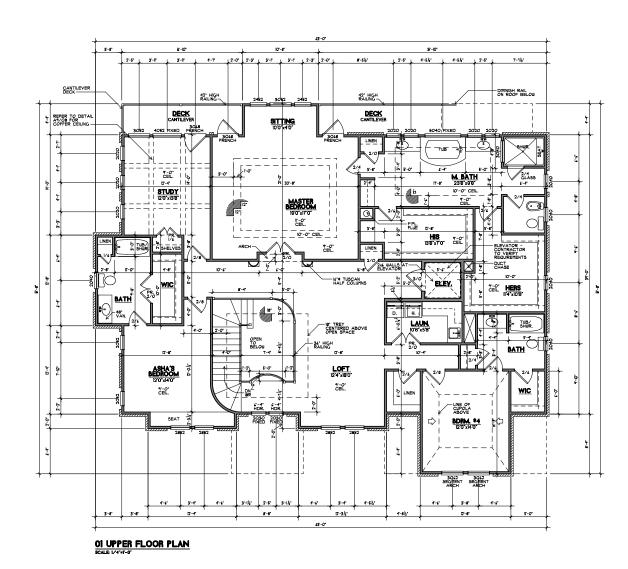
Terrace Level

3. ANNUAL ASSESSMENTS
